

Wanting to Recycle? Now you can.



All you have to do is gather and sort your recyclables and bring them to the Cleburne Transfer Station at

2625 Pipeline Road. All Cleburne and

Johnson County residents whose communities do not provide recycling are welcome to use this [free](#) service.

The following items can be recycled:

Plastics



Only type 1 or 2 plastic bottles, jugs and other plastic packaging. Soda & water bottles, plastic milk jugs, detergent and food bottles, plastic jars, and some produce and bakery product containers may be recycled. Just look for the chasing arrows emblem with number 1 or 2 inside (like pictured above). Please remove all food products, rinse containers, and remove caps or lids that don't have the recycling emblem. **NO plastic toys, butter tubs, Styrofoam, buckets, or anything without a 1 or 2. Please NO plastic grocery bags** (they foul the equipment).

Metal-Steel, Aluminum, Tin



Any 'tin', aluminum, or steel, beverage & food cans and metal lids can be recycled. **Please rinse items first!**

Bulky metals are also welcome.

No items containing Freon, like air conditioners or refrigerators can be accepted.



Paper Items



Newspapers, junk mail, magazines, coupons, envelopes, and phone books, etc. Collect all your mixed papers in brown paper grocery bags then toss the entire bag into the bin. **No plastic bags!**

Cardboard



Corrugated cardboard and all press board 'cereal type' boxes are accepted. **Flatten boxes before placing in the bin - No food contaminated boxes (i.e. pizza boxes!)**



Glass Recycling

There are two separate bins for recycling glass, one for clear glass; the other for all colored glass. Please rinse containers and **remove lids, caps, corks, and bottle tops.**

Clear Glass

Sort clear glass bottles and jars separately because they are in highest demand for recycled glass production.



Colored Glass

All other colors of glass can be mixed in the same bin. **We do not accept:** mirrors, china, drinking glasses, auto glass, window glass, light bulbs, ceramics, or porcelain.
